

Special Education Monthly Report – November 2016

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SPECIAL EDUCATION STATS: Since the last board meeting in October:

- Scholars with Individualized Education Plans increased from 48 to 49
- 3- parental request for Special Education Evaluations or additional services
- 6- Individualized Education Plan reviews
 - 1 scholar approved for Individualized Education Plan
 - 4- scholars IEP'S renewed for 1 year
 - 1 – CSE approval for scholar to an alternative academic setting
 - 1 -scholar approved for additional support services
 - 1 -scholars approved for additional academic services (SETSS)

Extra support is provided daily to the 5th and 2nd grade teams, during the ELA block to assist with those scholars who continue to struggle. In addition, weekly SpED team meetings are held to discuss:

Child Study Team - The Special Education Department is currently collaborating with all teachers, in monitoring all CST referrals. Several teachers are finalizing Tier III, and will make the necessary referral upon completion. There are 25 scholars currently being evaluated for referral to the Child Study Team (K-5).
